Approved: Resolution 13-20 opposing construction of a Sand and Gravel Mine and associated operations north of Olive Avenue on the beds and banks of the Agua Fria River.

Approved: Resolution 13-12, ordering that an ad valorem tax be fixed, levied and assessed on the assessed value of all real and personal property in the Agua Fria Ranch Street Lighting Improvement District in amounts specified in the filed Statements and Estimates; and providing for certified copies of this Resolution and Order to be delivered to the Maricopa County Board of Supervisors and the Arizona Department of Revenue; and providing that this Resolution shall be effective after its passage and approval according to law.
