

ORDINANCE NO. 18-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF YOUNGTOWN, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE CODE OF YOUNGTOWN, ARIZONA, TITLE 2 ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 2.04 TOWN COUNCIL, SECTION 2.04.080 REGULAR MEETINGS; RELATED TO CHANGING THE TIME FOR COUNCIL MEETINGS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Youngtown, Arizona, as follows:

Section I. In General.

The Code of Youngtown, Arizona, Title 2 Administration and Personnel, Chapter 2.04 Town Council, Section 2.04.080 Regular Meetings is hereby amended to read as follows (deletions shown in ~~strikeout~~; additions shown in ALL CAPS):

2.04.080 - Regular Meetings.

The council shall hold regular meetings and work sessions on the first and third Thursday of each month beginning at ~~seven p.m.~~ A TIME DESIGNATED BY COUNCIL RESOLUTION, except when the day fixed for any regular meeting of the council falls upon a day designated by law as a legal holiday or national holiday, such meeting shall be held at the same hour on the preceding day not a holiday unless otherwise noticed by the town. The council may hold study sessions as needed. All meetings of the council shall be held in the council chambers of the town, except that the council may schedule executive sessions, special study sessions or council retreats elsewhere. No final action may be taken at an executive session, a study session or a council retreat, except that the mayor may appoint special study committees at retreats or study sessions.

Section II. Providing for Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference, are hereby repealed.

Section III. Providing for Severability.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.




