3. Call for Motion to Convene into Executive Session:

- A. Convene Executive Session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(4) for discussion or consultation with the Town Attorney in order to consider its position and instruct the Town Attorney regarding the Town's position regarding a possible contract to engage an independent surveyor to conduct, evaluate and process survey responses from Town residents.
- B. Convene Executive Session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3) for discussion for legal advice with the Town Attorney related to the legal methods by which the question of whether to establish an initial primary property tax may be placed on a ballot for a vote by the qualified electors of the Town of Youngtown.
- C. Convene Executive Session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3) for discussion for legal advice with the Town Attorney relating to campaign activities of Town of Youngtown employees.
- D. Convene Executive Session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3) for discussion for legal advice with the Town Attorney regarding legal options of the Town in the event of the Town's failure to generate sufficient revenues.
- E. Convene Executive Session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3) for discussion for legal advice with the Town Attorney related to options for providing public safety services.

4. Adjourn Executive Session and reconvene Special Meeting


- A. Discussion and/or Action Re: Establishment of an initial property tax to be placed on the ballot for vote by qualified electors of Youngtown.
- B. Discussion and/or Action Re: Options in the event the Town fails to generate sufficient revenues to meet budgetary needs.
- C. Discussion and/or Action Re: Approval of Town Manager to enter into a contract for professional services with an independent surveyor to conduct a survey of Town residents at an amount not to exceed \$20,000 and authorizing the Town Manager to execute the contract.
