However, this holiday traditionally presents the biggest fire danger to citizens and is responsible for a great number of fires and burn injuries due to fireworks.

Fireworks include devices which make a visible or audible effect when set off. Although the State of Arizona has approved the use of small fireworks it is a violation of the Youngtown Town Code for any person to blast or use fireworks within the town limits.

Restrictions on fireworks are placed for a good cause. No matter how small or large a firework may be, it is a potential fire starter. However, it is still possible to celebrate and enjoy the holiday. Families can attend one of several approved, licensed fireworks displays around the Valley. The Town of Youngtown will not be holding a Fourth of July celebration this year.

Free fair housing workshop and seminar offered June 6

The first session will be a three hour training geared toward realtors, property managers/owners, leasing agents and other housing professionals. Realtors attending the three hour workshop can earn ADRE-authorized fair housing REALTOR re-licensing credit. The

second session will be 1.5-hour seminar that will summarize fair housing law, but will not provide credit.





Phase-I of Youngtown Fireflow Improvement Project to begin

Hello from your Public Works Department! Here's a quick update on Phase-I of the upcoming fireflow improvement project: It is now set to begin. Council has approved the contract for installation and we have a pre-construction meeting with the contractor scheduled the first part of June.

As soon as we know when the contractor plans to mobilize on site we will announce a neighborhood meeting at the Clubhouse, where residents and business-owners can come to learn how the project will affect the streets in front of their homes or businesses, and how the contractor will arrange to keep avenues of ingress/egress available. We'll also be able to answer your questions about the project and its timeline. Notices

will be posted at all public notice sites and on the Town's website as soon as we can set the date and time.

We anticipate being able to install over 4,000 linear feet of six-inch pipe and several new fire hydrants. The project will take place in the Town's right-of-way and will involve excavating trenches in the streets west of 111th Avenue from

Grand to Tennessee avenues. The project will require traffic diversion at times, but the contractor will be responsible to assure that access to homes and businesses is kept open.



What is this? Ranch Brand led town

Located on the Youngtown Clubhouse chimney is the above Greer Ranch brand. Curiosity and an interest to nail down the origin of this ranch brand led Town Manager Lloyce Robinson to do some research.

Arizona Dept. of Agriculture employee "Suzette", who is an ardent supporter of all aspects of ranch brands, was a wealth of information. Brands are to be registered each five years and if not, then

someone else may register the brand. Following is the timeline for the T Lazy V ranch brand for the Greer Ranch:

- 1908 – Originated by Francis(ces?) Wagoner

- 1920 – Registered by Frances E. Greer (new registration)

- 1961 – Registered by R.G. Buckaleu, Tucson, AZ (note last name difference from state records) www.buckalewfarm.com (new registration)

A strong possibility is in the early 1960's Mrs. Greer, upon conveying the ranch buildings and property to the Town of Youngtown, vacated or did not register her ranch's brand after 1960 - 61. It

was then registered by the "Buckalew Farms", southwest of Tucson on the road to Ajo, AZ.

If this story peaks your interest, visit the Youngtown Historical Museum, 112th and Alabama Avenues, Youngtown. Inquire at the Library and Manager Nancy Lewis will provide you with a very interesting visit of the Museum.

From the bench... Trunk Search Warrant

One of the many duties of a judge is to review and issue search warrants on criminal matters. Some time ago I issued a search warrant that reminded me of a well-known 1931 Arizona homicide case. The infamous

“Trunk Murderess” Winnie Ruth Judd was convicted of shooting her two female roommates in Phoenix, Arizona that year. It was alleged that she, along with someone that had a fair knowledge of bone anatomy, meticulously dismembered the two women, packed them in a couple steamer trunks and shipped them by train to Los Angeles. Blood seeping from one of the trunks was ultimately the beginning of Winnie’s undoing. She was caught, convicted of her crimes and escaped several times from the State Mental Hospital...but that is another story.

The search warrant I issued reminded me of the Judd case because the victim in

this murder was also stored in a trunk. The victim’s remains were discovered in the Arizona desert. The desert area just north of the Phoenix area has always been a well-known location where murderers have disposed of their victim’s bodies.

Police had received a tip from an informant about a homicide that had allegedly occurred in the North Valley area. The informant stated that the victim, a Caucasian male

in his 20’s, was shot in the head with a small caliber weapon. Subsequent to the execution style killing, the victim was bludgeoned with a heavy hammer, breaking the bones in the body until pliable enough to fit into a trunk.

The informant described how the body was covered with lye and lime powder in an attempt to contain the odor, wrapped in a plastic sheet, then fitted and sealed into a trunk. The informant stated that the trunk was kept in his home for some time before he and the murder suspect transported it to the desert area where they opened the trunk and buried the remains in a

shallow grave just to the East side of the I-17. The informant escorted the Police and members of the Maricopa County Medical Examiner's Office to the grave site near the base of a large skeletonized saguaro cactus. The victim's remains were then excavated and transported to the Medical Examiner's office for an autopsy. It appeared the decedent did in fact have a bullet hole in head as the informant described and that the body was positioned in a way that indicated it had been in a confined small

rectangular space. A black plastic trunk that smelled of a foul odor and coated with a white powder was located near the grave site...all consistent in corroborating the informant's story. About this same time, a different informant provided tips regarding this homicide, as well as another related homicide that occurred in Nevada. The informant stated that the perpetrator of the crime, who was only known by his nickname, disassembled and disposed of the gun used as the murder weapon. Neither

the gun nor any of the parts were ever located by authorities. This informant was already incarcerated on separate charges, but cooperated with police in their efforts in solving the Arizona crime. Police stated that both homicides were likely related to the illicit drug trade, and to date, have not caught the suspect. The explicit details of a crime listed in a search warrant affidavit are often gruesome but necessary in determining probable cause for its issuance. Even after decades of reading these affidavits

for warrants, it is difficult to understand how some human beings can be so devoid of conscience as to commit the heinous crimes that occur in our society. Time will tell if this "trunk murderer" will ever be brought to justice.
