Case Z19-07- Request for a Variance for property located at 11112 W. Indiana Avenue, Youngtown, Arizona 85363. Applicant seeks a variance from the requirements of Title 17 Zoning, Chapter 17.24 R-3 Single Family Dwelling District, Section 17.24.100 Fence Regulations, Item A. Fences or freestanding walls or hedges shall not exceed six feet in height in any side or rear year, or thirty-six (36 inches in any front yard. (Dimensions are nominal). Construction of any fence or wall shall require a building permit. The effect of the variance would be to allow a fence of six (6) feet high in the front yard which is three (3) feet higher than what is currently permitted by code.
